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1 Modification to the Foreword

In the paragraph after the list of standards, replace the reference to EC directive "2006/60/EEC" with "2006/122/EC" to read as follows:

"As fire fighting foams are chemical agents or chemical preparations EC directives 1967/548/EEC, 1999/45/EEC, Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 (REACH) and 2006/122/EC apply and should be taken into account."

2 Modification to the Introduction

In the last paragraph, replace the reference to EC directive "2006/60/EEC" with "2006/122/EC" to read as follows:

"It is extremely important that the foam concentrate after dilution with water to the recommended concentration should not in normal usage present a significant toxic hazard to life in relation to the environment. The current versions of EC directives 67/548/EEC, 2006/122/EC, 1999/45/EEC and Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 apply when considering the testing of ecotoxicological properties and safety in the work environment."
