Foreword

Add:

Within the European Union some legal provisions may be different from what is indicated in this standard. As these legal provisions are adopted by the European Parliament and the Council they supersede the rules and recommendations of this standard wherever they are conflicting. In particular EU legislation does not make any difference between a “MR Worker“ and a “Worker” and occupational health and safety provisions apply to all categories without distinction. Currently, the Directive 2004/40/EC for the protection of workers exposed to risks arising from electromagnetic fields – albeit under review – foresees more stringent exposure limit values for workers. These occupational limits will have to be implemented by all Member States by 30 April 2012 unless the review process leads to the adoption by the European Parliament and the Council of other values before that date.
