Technical Corrigendum 2 to ISO 20347:2004 was prepared by the European Committee for Standardization (CEN) in collaboration with Technical Committee ISO/TC 94, *Personal safety — Protective clothing and equipment*, Subcommittee SC 3, *Foot protection*, in accordance with the Agreement on technical cooperation between ISO and CEN (Vienna Agreement).

Page 8, Clause 5.1, General

Replace the first two paragraphs with the following sentence:

"Occupational footwear shall comply with the basic requirements given in Table 2, and additionally with at least one of the requirements for whole footwear given in Table 12."

Page 9, Table 2 — Basic requirements for occupational footwear

Insert the following full-width row after the rows relating to "Quarter lining":

At the end of the final sentence of the Note to Table 2, add the following sentence:

[&]quot;For classification II footwear, it is usual to have no insole present. However, if an insock is used, testing is not mandatory but it should be treated in accordance with option 1 in Table 3."
