1 Scope

This International Standard presents the detailed requirements specific to this type of cable to ensure compatibility with ISO/IEC 11801, *Information technology – Generic cabling for customer premises*. The requirements of the Family Specification IEC 60794-2-10:2011 are applicable to cables covered by this standard.

Particular requirements detailed in clause 4 either define a specific option relative to the requirements of IEC 60794-2-10:2011 or define additional requirements.

3 General requirements

The cable shall comply with the family specification (IEC 60794-2-10:2011) and meet the requirements that are defined in it.

The optical fibre contained in the cables which are covered by this standard shall comply with one of the following standards and meet the normative requirements defined within them as applicable:
