Foreword

This European Standard has been prepared by Technical Committee CEN/TC 187 "Refractory products and materials", the secretariat of which is held by BSL.

EN 1094 "Insulating refractory products" consists of 7 parts:

- Part 1 Terminology for ceramic fibre products
- Part 2 Classification of shaped products
- Part 3 Classification of ceramic fibre products (ENV)
- Part 4 Determination of bulk density and true porosity of shaped products
- Part 5 Determination of cold crushing strength of shaped products
- Part 6 Determination of permanent change in dimensions on heating of shaped products
- Part 7 Methods of test for ceramic fibre products (ENV)

This European Standard shall be given the status of a national standard, either by publication of an identical text or by endorsement, at the latest by September 1997, and conflicting national standards shall be withdrawn at the latest by September 1997.
