Textiles — Nonwovens — Definition

1 Scope

This International Standard establishes a definition for the term nonwovens.

2 Terms and definitions

For the purposes of this document, the following terms and definitions apply.

2.1

nonwovens

nonwovens are structures of textile materials, such as fibres, continuous filaments, or chopped yarns of any nature or origin, that have been formed into webs by any means, and bonded together by any means, excluding the interlacing of yarns as in woven fabric, knitted fabric, laces, braided fabric or tufted fabric

NOTE Film and paper structures are not considered as nonwovens.

nontissé

structure constituée de matières textiles, comme des fibres, des filaments continus ou des fils coupés, quelle qu'en soit la nature ou l'origine, formée en voile par un moyen quelconque, et liée par tout moyen, excluant l'entrelacement de fils comme dans une étoffe tissée, tricotée, en dentelle, tressée ou touffetée

NOTE Les structures film et papier ne sont pas considérées comme du nontissé.
