1 Scope

This document specifies functional requirements (see Clause 5) and safety requirements (see Clause 6) for table tennis tables hereafter referred to as tables.

This document is applicable to five types of tables (see Table 2) within the Classes A to D (see Table 1).

3 Terms and definitions

For the purposes of this document, the following terms and definitions apply.

3.1

table tennis table

complete equipment without net assembly

3.2

tabletop

half of a table (including the playing board, the finish and lines of the playing surface, the frames and other reinforcements under the board especially around its end and side, the markings on the frames and any device holding or attaching together both halves) divided at the net without any undercarriage

3.3

full tabletop

two tabletops assembled in the playing position

3.4

undercarriage

all of the elements whose principal function is to support the tabletop

3.5

playing position

both tabletops are in a horizontal position with net assembly attached

3.6

playback position

one tabletop is in a horizontal and the other one in a vertical position with the net assembly attached

3.7

storage position

both tabletops are in a vertical position

3.8

net assembly

net, its suspension and the supporting posts, including the system attaching it to the table
