BRIEF HISTORY

The ISO Recommendation R 325, *Wood Cones for Cross Winding—Half Angle of the Cone 4° 20'*, was drawn up by Technical Committee ISO/TC 72, *Textile Machinery and Accessories*, the Secretariat of which is held by the Association Suisse de Normalisation (SNV).

Work on this question by the Technical Committee began in 1951 and led, in 1960, to the adoption of a Draft ISO Recommendation.

In August 1961, this Draft ISO Recommendation (No. 454) was circulated to all the ISO Member Bodies for enquiry. It was approved, subject to a few modifications of an editorial nature, by the following Member Bodies:
