FOREWORD

ISO (the International Organization Standardization) is a worldwide federation of national standards institutes (ISO Member Bodies). As part of the process, Technical Committee ISO/TC 72 has reviewed ISO Recommendation F(\$72 and found it technically suitable for transformation. International Standard 69 572 therefore replaces ISO Recommendation R 572-1967 to which it is technically identical.
