ISO 15087-4 : 2000 Dental elevators – Part 4: Coupland elevators, which was prepared by ISO/TC 106 'Dentistry' of the International Organization for Standardization, has been adopted by Technical Committee CEN/TC 55 'Dentistry', the Secretariat of which is held by DIN, as a European Standard.

1 Scope

This part of ISO 15087 gives requirements, including dimensions, for Coupland dental elevators.

NOTE These instruments are also called osseous chisels.

2 Normative references

3 Terms and definitions

For the purposes of this part of ISO 15087, the terms and definitions given in ISO 1942-3 apply.

4 Design and dimensions

4.1 General

4.1.1 Coupland elevators shall conform to the general requirements given in ISO 15087-1.

4.1.2 Coupland elevators shall be grouped into the following types according to the shape of the working end:

- Type 1 = Straight, small working end
- Type 2 = Straight, medium working end
- Type 3 = Straight, large working end

4.1.3 Coupland elevators shall be designed in accordance with Figure 1, and with dimensions according to Table 1. Measurements of dimensions should be made as defined in Table 2.

NOTE Annex A of ISO 15087-1:1999 provides details of one method of measurement applicable to most types of dental hand instrument.
