ISO 2157:1992 Dental rotary instruments; nominal diameters and designation code number, which was prepared by ISO/TC 106 'Dentistry' of the International Organization for Standardization, has been adopted by Technical Committee CEN/TC 55 'Dentistry' as a European Standard.

The text was submitted for the Updating Questionnaire Procedure (UQ) and approved as a European Standard.

This European Standard supersedes EN 22 157:1989.

This European Standard shall be given the status of a national standard, either by publication of an identical text or by endorsement, and conflicting national standards withdrawn, by August 1995 at the latest.
