Foreword

This document (EN 14528:2007) has been prepared by Technical Committee CEN/TC 163 "Sanitary appliances", the secretariat of which is held by UNI.

This European Standard shall be given the status of a national standard, either by publication of an identical text or by endorsement, at the latest by October 2007, and conflicting national standards shall be withdrawn at the latest by January 2009.

This document supersedes EN 14528:2005.

This standard is one of a series of harmonized standards for sanitary appliances which have been prepared under the Mandate M/110 "Sanitary Appliances" which was given to CEN by the European Commission and the European Free Trade Association to allow CE marking under the Construction Products Directive (89/106/EEC).

For relationship with EU Directive(s), see informative Annex ZA, which is an integral part of this document.

The main reason for the revision of standard is the incorporation of the overflow requirement according to the amendment to Mandate M/110 and of the new designation and marking approach according to latest decisions taken by CEN/TC 163.

1 Scope

This European Standard specifies the functional requirements and test methods for bidets used for domestic purposes and made from either ceramics or stainless steel.

NOTE 1 All drawings are examples only, other forms are permissible.

NOTE 2 For the purposes of this standard the term 'domestic purposes' includes use in hotels, accommodation for students, hospitals and similar buildings, except when special medical provisions are required.

bidet

sanitary appliance for washing the genital area whilst seated




Figure 1 — Wall-hung bidet
