1 Scope

This part of ISO 8367 specifies a set of tolerances applicable to the manufacture of paper sacks as defined in ISO 6590-1.

2 Normative references

3 Tolerances

The paper sacks to be measured shall be sampled in accordance with ISO 7023.

The grammage of the plies shall be determined in accordance with ISO 536.

The dimensions shall be described and measured in accordance with ISO 6591-1. The tolerances of the dimensions shall be within the limits specified in table 1. If closer tolerances are required, this shall be agreed between purchaser and supplier.
